Teaching



High quality phonics training has been delivered for all staff and sessions are delivered each half term.

Pupil support team available to offer support and advice in lessons. Middle leaders and subject leaders regularly review the curriculum and assessment tools.

Targeted academic support

Small group Maths interventions delivered by an experienced HLTA.

Assessment cycles are termly and any students struggling are highlighted by subject leads.
